- SAGE Summative is an UN-timed test. Time guidelines are estimates.
- Number of session guidelines can be altered to suit local situation.
- Totals -- 3 sessions and 2.5 hours for Grades 3 -5

ELA Part One: **Reading – Listening – Language**

- Two (2) Sessions
- 45 mins each

- Reading
 - Single and Paired Passages
 - Literary / Informational ratio follows core (elem. 50:50)
- Listening
 - 1 minute passage – dialogue - discussion
 - Headphones required
- Language
 - Edit passage
 - Vocabulary

- **Question Types** that could be seen:
 - **Selected** Response
 - Multiple Choice
 - w/ single correct answers
 - w/ multiple correct answers
 - Hot Spot
 - Drag & Drop
 - **Constructed** Response
 - Short Answer
 - Create or complete chart-graph-or diagram

ELA Part Two: **Writing**

- One (1) Session
- 60 mins each

- Writings
 - Students will write in response to information and/or evidence from a passage, image, audio (stimuli)
 - In response to this stimuli, ALL students will generate two (2) compositions
 - #1 = **Informative / Explanatory**
 - Shorter
 - #2 = **Opinion / Argument**
 - Longer
 - FYI: Students will have spell check
 - FYI: Students will NOT have grammar check

2013-14 SAGE Summative: MATH Test

- SAGE Summative is an UN-timed test. Time guidelines are estimates.
- Number of session guidelines can be altered to suit local situation.
- Totals -- 2 sessions and 1.5 hours for Grades 3 -5

MATH

- Two (2) Sessions
- 45 mins each

- 3rd grade = 45 questions
- 4th grade = 50 questions
- 5th grade = 50 questions

- **Question Types** that could be seen:
 - **Selected** Response
 - Multiple Choice
 - w/ single correct answers
 - w/ multiple correct answers
 - Hot Spot
 - Drag & Drop
 - **Constructed** Response
 - Short Answer
 - Create or complete chart-graph-or diagram

- FYI: Students will NOT have a calculator (onscreen nor personal)
- FYI: Students will NOT have reference sheet
 - any formula needed for a question will be provided in the question materials

- Totals -- 2 sessions and 1.5 hours for Grades 4 -5

SCIENCE

- Two (2) Sessions
- 45 mins each

- 3rd grade = N/A
- 4th grade = 48 questions
- 5th grade = 45 questions

- **Question Types** that could be seen:
 - **Selected** Response
 - Multiple Choice
 - w/ single correct answers
 - w/ multiple correct answers
 - Hot Spot
 - Drag & Drop
 - **Constructed** Response
 - Short Answer
 - Create or complete chart-graph-or diagram

- **Simulations**

Students may see a simulation. Questions regarding the simulation may require manipulation of the simulation and/or interpretation / analysis of the displayed results
