

## **PTA Meeting minutes**

**September 1, 2015**

The meeting commenced at 8:20am.

**Shelly welcomed everybody** and introduced the board to the members.

- She gave a demo of the webpage and encouraged everybody to use it
- Reminded about PTA newsletter and to enroll if not getting it
- Encouraged folks to use the community bulletin board

**Mr. Gomez gave a brief welcome.** New staff includes Amanda West DLI English side 1<sup>st</sup> grade. Kara Cook for non-DLI 1<sup>st</sup> grade. Hope Malloy is covering the class now while Kara is on maternity leave. Kara Wales, was ELL Specialist, is back in classroom in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade non-DLI. Alisa Oakley, was Special Ed., is back in the classroom in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade non-DLI. Noemi Bonilla is the new 3<sup>rd</sup> grade DLS Spanish teacher. The new teachers are off to a great start.

Noemi is new to the country and has limited furniture. If you have things around that you can give her, let David know.

Ms. Waugaman our guidance counselor is holding a coffee hour once a month. Last Monday of the month 8am Teachers' Lounge starting in September in ENGLISH. Last Friday of the month 10/2 8am Teachers' Lounge in SPANISH. These are parent forums to address whatever concerns you have.

Mr. Gomez introduced the new specialist rotation calendar to which dance and art have been added this year. This will help us to educate the whole child AND organize our day. Thanks to Park City Education Foundation for funding these new specialists. The new setup makes the groups smaller as well. Recall that last year we started to mix kids up (between homerooms and DLI/non) for the specialist rotations.

He discussed the Fun Friday setup and how it will allow time for teacher training as well as encourage kids to complete their assignments and homework.

Don't be afraid to make an appointment to discuss any concerns with Mr. Gomez. Also you can catch him on the playground during lunch recess daily.

Aides have been assigned to each grade level. P-30 time: Testing and assessment illuminate student needs and we use all of our specialists for small student groups to address any concerns. This is built-in time for teachers to do special testing or instruction as the aides and specialists

help with the class small groups. Reyna Velazquez has moved into this role. Sheila Kirst is now working at the front desk. Dawn Rametta has moved into the reading intervention specialist role.

The school year is off to a great start.

**Mike reviewed the 15-16 PTA budget.** We had \$8,700 left over at the end of last year. We also have a planned surplus for this year. If you have ideas for how to spend this money please send them to us. He discussed that we are in terrific financial shape this year.

**Julie Eihausen and JJ Ehlers from the PCSD Board of Education gave a presentation.**

Their visit was to address questions about school district plans, most notably the capital spending plans to address deteriorating buildings and student growth. JJ introduced the board's new mission. Then she showed student growth and building capacity. ### **Chair Updates:**

**Park City Education Foundation.** Meg Parker is the Ambassador for PCEF this year. She reviewed the many, many programs that PCEF funds at PPES. Here are some highlights re: what's going on with PCEF:

- Teacher grant applications are due October 15.
- Red Apple Gala – we need volunteers to help set up. It's a 2-hour time commitment.
- Right now is *Beat the Call* which encourages donations from every child (family) in every classroom. The school with the highest family participation gets a \$2,500 grant.
