It's time to start studying! The Park Record Spelling Bee will take place Tuesday March 7, 2017 at the Egyptian Theatre and will be again be divided into two Bees – a 2nd - 3rd grade Bee & a 4th - 8th grade Bee. The champion of the 4th - 8th grade Park Record Bee will represent Summit & Wasatch counties in the 2016 Scripps National Spelling Bee in DC.

There will be separate written qualifiers for 2nd - 3rd grades and 4th - 8th grades and there will *only be spelling* on the tests this year.

You can study for the qualifier tests now using the grade-level lists from Scripps. Second & third grade spellers should study the 1st-3rd grade words and 4th-8th grade spellers should study all of the word lists.
